The Feast of Epiphany teaches us quite a bit.

It teaches us about darkness. We know that the Pharisees and scholars who studied the Scriptures, who knew about Bethlehem and the coming of the Messiah CHOSE the darkness and REFUSED the star. It teaches us that darkness does not come only from fate or bad luck. Darkness can come from our own making or choosing.

It teaches us about wisdom. We learn not to lose hope in the midst of darkness. The star appeared and disappeared from the Magi's sight but they kept going. Sometimes we see our way clearly on life's journey and sometimes we fail to see our way. When that happens, God's wisdom teaches us to not lose hope. The star always returns.

It teaches us to bring gifts. The Magi came with open hearts and they recognized one greater than themselves and they offered their gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh. We may not have those particular gifts but we can offer our work, our time, talents, treasure, our hearts.
