Paul quotes Psalm 118 when he states that Jesus is “the stone rejected by you, the builders, which has become the cornerstone”. Jesus is the cornerstone of our faith, to be sure, for his life, death, and resurrection provide its foundation. We are called to make him the cornerstone of our lives as well so that we may be living temples of the Lord, embodying his message and the mission he left us. We do so when we give of ourselves to God and to others.

John tells us that we are God’s children. Children are formed by their parents, perhaps genetically, perhaps by the way they were raised, perhaps by the influence of their parents’ personality and character. So too are we formed by God, made in God’s image, cared for by God, and influenced by our understanding of God. Jesus, as God’s Son, has given us a model of how to live as a child of God. Jesus put the Father’s will first, obedient to the end. As we recite in the Lord’s Prayer, we too pray that we do the will of the Father in the way that we live our lives.

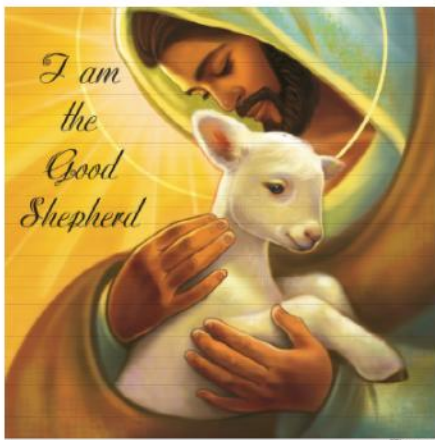
Jesus is the Good Shepherd, willing to lay down his life for the sheep. He tells his disciples that he received this command from the Father. So too have we, called to die to our own selves to raise up the lives of others, whether sacrificing our time and energy to care for a young child, an aging parent, a loved one who is ill, or a friend in need. 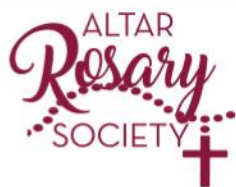
2024 KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS SCHOLARSHIP
